Women Empowerment Cell celebrated International Women's Day on Tuesday 8th March 2022 in the Library Reference Hall, SJR College at 10.30 am. The celebration began with thoughtful prayer by the students from BBA Department. Ms. Sujata M Naik, Convener, Women Empowerment Cell welcomed the gathering and introduced the Chief Guest, Dr. Jayashree Salimath, .

Dr. Jayashree Salimath, spoke on this occasion about the women empowerment and brought awareness among the students about the legal rights of the women in our country. She explained that the women are often the target of crimes and not know how to defend themselves. She urged the girls to be strong and encouraged to acquire legal knowledge to defend themselves. She highlighted some of the important legal issues in the families such as the child marriage, child labour, Property issues, ancestral property rights etc. According to the Hindu Succession Act, women are entitled to get equal share in the property of their parents. She brought to the notice of the gathering about the amendment of laws in which the age of marriage for girls has raised to 21 years as equal to the boys. Women are entitled to get maternity leave, crèches, gratuity, bonus, pf, etc and she was sad that these laws are not implemented effectively. However the students were made aware of the rights of the women and laws pertaining to their protection.

While concluding she requested the principal to give an opportunity to conduct a legal awareness programme for the students of our college by resource persons so that the students should feel strong having legal knowledge to bring positive changes in the society. Dr. S. Kantharaju, Principal addressed the students. He advised them to respect their parents and faithful to them and advised them to learn to respect each other especially the ladies and to become good human beings.

Prof .Chaithra, Department of Commerce shared her opinions about the long-lasting struggles of women even at the present age of advanced science and technology. She advised the girls to face the problems of their life bravely and live their life independently.

Smt. Shubha, Department of Computer Science delivered the vote of thanks. The event was enthusiastically hosted by Ms. Reshma Bhaskar, Department of Commerce and the programme was successfully winded up with the pleasant piano and flute performance by the students of BCA
