


Objective: To invoke conscious approach to soil and planet in the students.





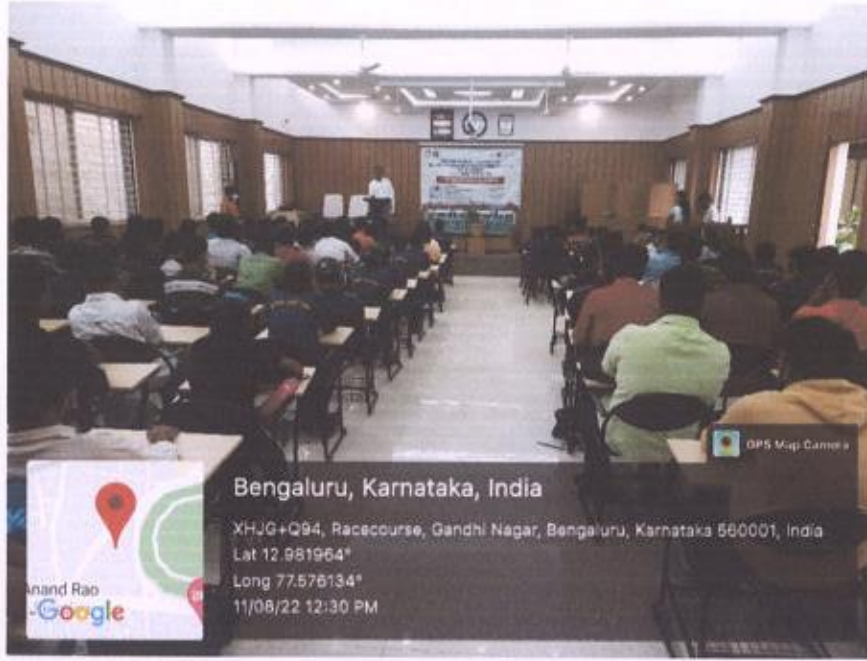
